A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING ANTHONY DIPIPPA AS AN ALTERNATE SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL

WHEREAS in accordance with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection regulatory requirement, 25 Pa. Code § 72.42, the Township of Hopewell is to appoint a Sewage Enforcement Officer and an Alternate Officer; and

WHEREAS the Township of Hopewell hereby appoints Anthony DiPippa, S.E.O of EADS Group, Inc. 732 Third Avenue, Suite 101, New Brighton, PA as Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the aforesaid Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer shall be paid compensation on an hourly basis as outlined in the Fee Schedule attached hereto or upon such other basis as may be mutually agreed upon between the Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer(s) and the Board of Commissioners for all work performed, as assigned by the Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the fee schedule applies to new and repair/replacement sewage systems. The Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer is authorized to perform soil testing for sewage planning purposes and to sign the false swearing statement in the planning module. The Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer is authorized to collect all related fees and shall submit such fees to the Township on a regular basis. The Township shall remit such fees to the Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer as payment for services rendered, except for the \$50.00 administration fee. The Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer(s) shall provide the Township with a project summary upon completion of each project or furnish the Board of Commissioners and Township Manager with reports, information or

estimates of any Township sewage enforcement work and/or respond to questions by any of them in their official capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, under the First Class Township Code, hereby appoints Anthony DiPippa as its Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer.
